• Enrolment fee

The non-refundable enrolment fee is only payable for new students. The fee covers administrative costs. The school retains the fee if the student cancels.

• Health insurance

Health insurance is compulsory in Switzerland. Boarders who are non-Swiss residents must be insured via the school. Parents pay the insurance premiums. The premiums are included in the boarding fees for boarders. Non-boarders are not insured by the school, but must have private health insurance valid in Switzerland. The school cannot be held liable if any student fails to obtain proper health insurance.

• Accident insurance

The school insures all students against accidents. The insurance covers accidents on the road leading to Lemania College, accidents within the school grounds, and accidents occurring on activities organised by the school, provided the student has health insurance valid in Switzerland and the EU.

• Drop-out and cancellation

Course fees are refunded if a student cancels up to 1 day before the programme begins (it takes 1 month to process the refund). The school will only retain the 150 CHF enrolment fee.

If a student drops out part-way through the programme, fees for the current and subsequent week will be charged. Fees paid for any subsequent months will be refunded (minus bank charges).

One month's boarding is chargeable by way of a penalty.

• Code of conduct

Learners must follow the school and/or boarding house rules at all times. Learners who are students at the school must conduct themselves appropriately and protect the school's reputation by acting as ambassadors. Lemania College reserves the right to eject a student from the classes or from the boarding house if his/her conduct falls below the acceptable standard. Learners sit the language test in Lausanne. If the test is sat in another city, the school will pass on the cost of one night's hotel accommodation plus transport.

Food allergies
